**CLOTH FIGURES**

Description: These sculptures in cloth combine animal and human features. Each is constructed using traditional doll-making techniques. Bodies and costumes are made from upcycled textiles, primarily fine wools, linens, and silks. Characteristics of each species is accurately represented by the textiles utilized. Most figures have jointed arms and legs to provide multiple display opportunities and all have hanging loops for wall display.

**SILK QUILTS**

Description: Traditional quilt patterns are reinterpreted using upcycled fabrics (linen shirts and silk neckties). These textiles exhibit a modern, graphic quality combined with a traditional aesthetic and can fit into many decorating styles. Each quilt body is constructed by machine, and all finishing, including quilting, is done by hand by the artist. All quilts have a hanging sleeve for wall display, but they are also completely functional as lap or couch quilts. Dry-cleaning recommended.

**BUILD-A-QUILTS**

Description: Each 48" quilt is composed of 16 unique patchwork blocks. Each block has two rows of buttonholes and buttons allowing the quilt to be taken apart and reconstructed in a variety of different combinations. Individual quilts follow a color theme and feature multiple patchwork patterns. The blocks are made from upcycled fabrics; no batting is used. Because of the use of buttons, *these quilts are not safe for children under the age of five.*

### **BETLE BROOCHES**

Description: These fabric brooches are made using a multistep embroidery process (called stumpwork) that transforms scraps of fabric and leather into miniature works of art. Bodies are made from recycled silk brocades (old neckties) and leather. Nearly all components are sewn together. Legs are made from leather covered wire; eyes are glass beads. Each beetle has a sterling plated pin back securely sewn in place.

### **DECOUPAGE JEWELRY**

Description: Unique jewelry items featuring decoupaged wooden beads. Recycled book pages (primarily dictionaries, maps, and children's books) are glued and sealed onto a wooden core. Necklaces combine glass beads, brass findings and decoupage beads. Jewelry is lightweight, colorful, and artistically unique.
